

Gentry High Scholarship Application Instructions

1. Applications **must** be typewritten.
2. Applications **must** be given to Mrs. Casebeer in the high school office on the following deadline dates: **March 6th and April 3rd**. The first deadline is **March 6th**. Mr. White will be given the applications to review for mistakes. On March 20th the applications will be returned to the students to make corrections. The final applications are due on **April 3rd**. Failure to make the 1st deadline will make students ineligible for the general scholarships. **STUDENTS MUST TURN THEIR APPLICATIONS IN BY 3:30 ON EACH DEADLINE DATE.** (No exceptions)
3. Applications should be free of errors.
4. A typed essay, of approximately 200 - 300 words in which you discuss your involvement, ambitions, and future plans should be stapled to the back of the application.
5. Applications should include an appropriate photo – no glamour shots, please. (Preferably a wallet size. These will not be returned.)
6. The following information must be obtained from the counselor.
 - A copy of your high school transcript
 - A copy of your ACT Composite Score.
You may either submit an official copy of your ACT score or the score can be included on the bottom of your transcript.
Your composite score should also be typed on page one of the application.
(If you have not taken the ACT, please specify.)
 - Grade Point Average (GPA) – to be typed on page one of the application.
 - Class Rank – to be typed on page one of the application.

GPA and Class Rank should reflect the student's completion of the 7th semester.

7. Only completed applications submitted in the following order will be considered for funding.

Applications should be stapled in the upper left-hand corner.

- 2) essay
- 3) transcript and ACT scores

***All questions should be answered. If a question is not applicable, blanks should be filled in with N/A.**
