

# Getting Started with

---

Below are basic instructions to assist teachers in getting started with JEdi. Please share this information with any teachers currently using JEdi.

Go to [www.jedilearning.com](http://www.jedilearning.com) and select “Login to My JEdi” at the top right-hand corner of the page. Then enter in your username, password and site like the example below.

**Username:** jdoe

**Password:** jdoe

**Site:** jedi08

**Lesson Content:** Once you have logged on select “View Activity” from the left-hand menu. This will allow you to view any of the pretests, posttests, and lessons. **This tool is only used to allow teachers to view the lessons; it does not retain any of the scores made by the teacher(s).** **Note:** To view any of the lessons make sure your computer has “Adobe Flash Player recommend version 9.” To download this free player go to [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com).

**Accountability Reports:** Select “View Tutorials” from the left-hand menu. Under the heading “Classroom Tools” this will allow you to view Sample Accountability Reports provided by this program. You can also view the Grade Equivalency Chart which will show you the grade levels covered by the different modules. In addition you can view the mini tutorial movies to assist you in getting started and the entire user guide. **Note:** To view any of the reports provided by this program make sure your computer has “Adobe Reader recommend version 8 or higher.” To download this free player go to [www.adobe.com](http://www.adobe.com).

**Guides & Worksheets:** Select “View Guides and Worksheets” from the left-hand menu. This will allow you to view an overview of each module and some of the worksheets that are aligned with some of the modules.

**Alignments:** Select “Teacher Properties” from the left-hand menu. This will allow you to activate the alignments by placing a check mark before all of the frameworks listed on your right or the only the ones you are interested in using. Then select “Done” from the left-hand menu to activate these alignments. Once activated these alignments can then be used to create assignments.
