2021-2022 Tuition Agreement **Northwest Technical Institute Secondary Career Center** **Gentry School District**

The Northwest Technical Institute Secondary Career Center, agrees to offer Career and Technical classes to students that have been accepted into the programs of study attending the Gentry School District in grades 11-12.

Classes will be offered through the Secondary Career Center in Automotive Service Technology, Criminal Justice, Medium and Heavy Truck Technology, Medical Professions/CNA, Medical Professions/CNA/PCA+, Medical Professions/Dental, Medical Professions Education, HVAC, and Welding. Students taking classes in these courses will receive secondary vocational credit at their home high school.

Students have an opportunity to earn industry certifications in Automotive Service Technology, Medium and Heavy Truck Technology, Medical Professions Education, and Welding. In addition to earning industry certifications, an SCC student must pass a class with a 70% or above, NWTTI will follow the provisions of Arkansas Statute 6-5-1004 as amended by Act 554 of 2017.

Upon successful completion of each course, students taking Criminal Justice, Medical Professions/CNA/PCA+, Medical Professions/Dental will also receive concurrent credit at NWACC leading to an Associate's Degree upon enrollment at NWACC after their high school graduation.

The Secondary Career Center agrees to notify the schools and parents when the student has accumulated excessive absences equal to one-half (1/2) the total number of absences permitted for the program of study the student is in. Certain programs of study may have their own requirements for attendance, and students should adhere to those attendance policies, if applicable, rather than the guidelines stated in the Secondary Career Center handbook.

All tuition is paid by the Arkansas Department of Education through vocational center aid.

Conditions:

1. Attendance is reported back to the home district according to the policy of the SCC Handbook.
2. Grade records will be provided quarterly (8 weeks) to the home district or as requested in writing to the SCC.
3. The Resident district agrees to attach any modifications for special needs or ELL students to his or her application.
4. No educational fees. All funding comes from vocational center aid.

Note: CNA expenses will include: CPR card, TB skin test, Flu Shot, Background Checks, or Drug Screenings.
