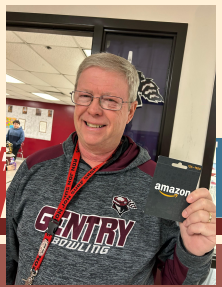
BOOKS ROCK!

Rocks will be voted on during our Book Fair! Prizes will be awarded!



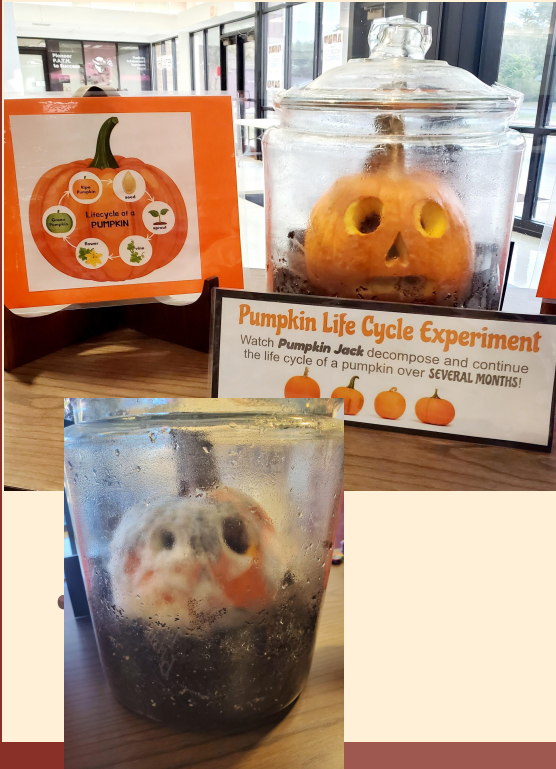
