Discussed Calendar Requirements

- 178 student days
- School must start with students no earlier than August 19 and no later than August 26.

Discussed staff and family survey regarding the calendar.

- The majority of parents don't have a preference how we do PT conferences. They want different options other than the traditional methods of conferencing such as,zoom, drop in, scheduled appointments available throughout the day.
- Parents want to see snow days built into the calendar somewhere other than the end of the school year.
- Staff would like to see two Flex days built into the calendar like this year.
- Staff would like their 12 hours of teacher directed curriculum planning to be in August before the start of school.
- Staff would like to have PD days built into the calendar like they were this year.
- Staff would also like to keep Parent Teacher conferences set up the way they were this year, a school day with students and then conferences till 8:00.
- Staff would like to have 6 hours of embedded PD built in to the calendar.
