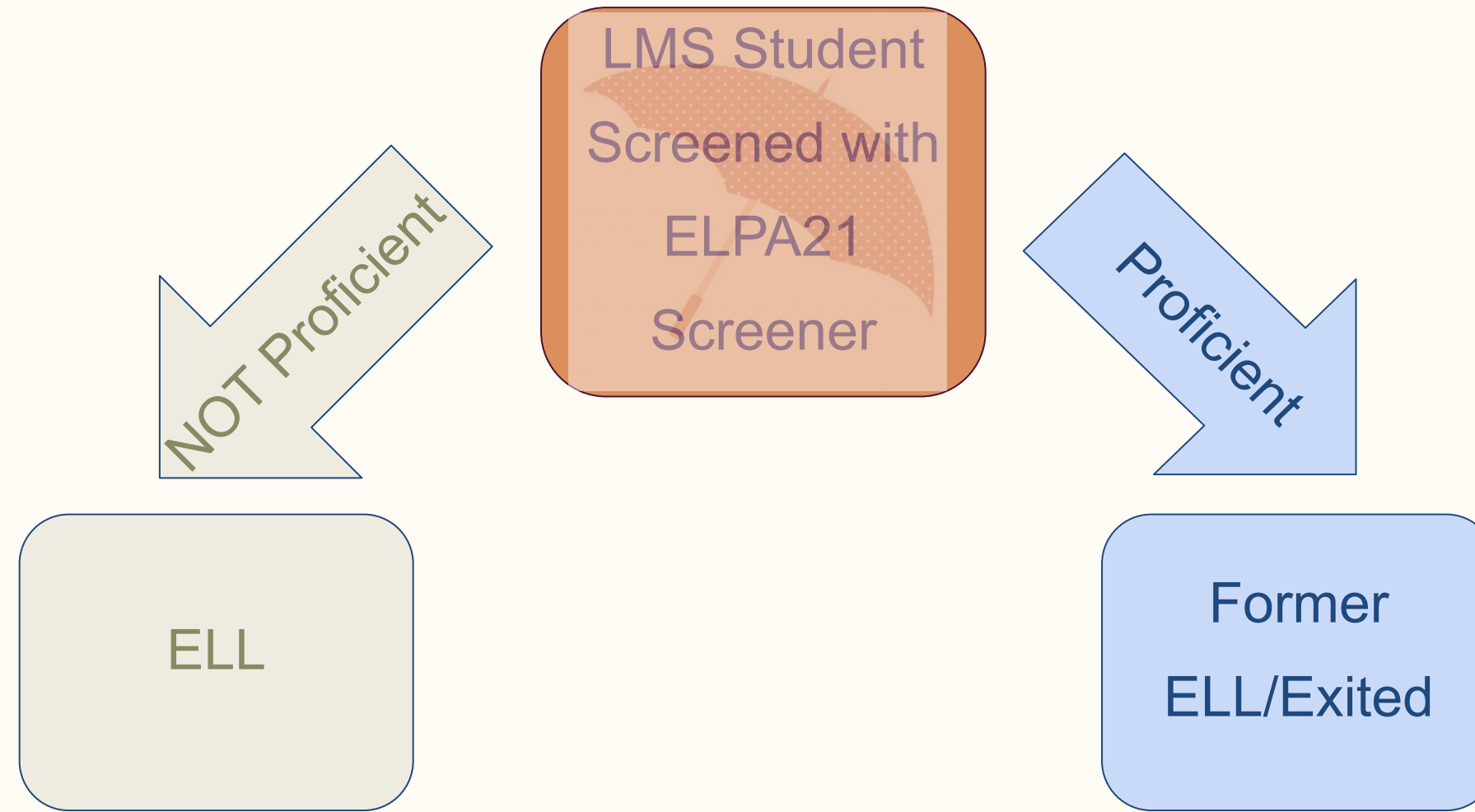
Belief & Vision

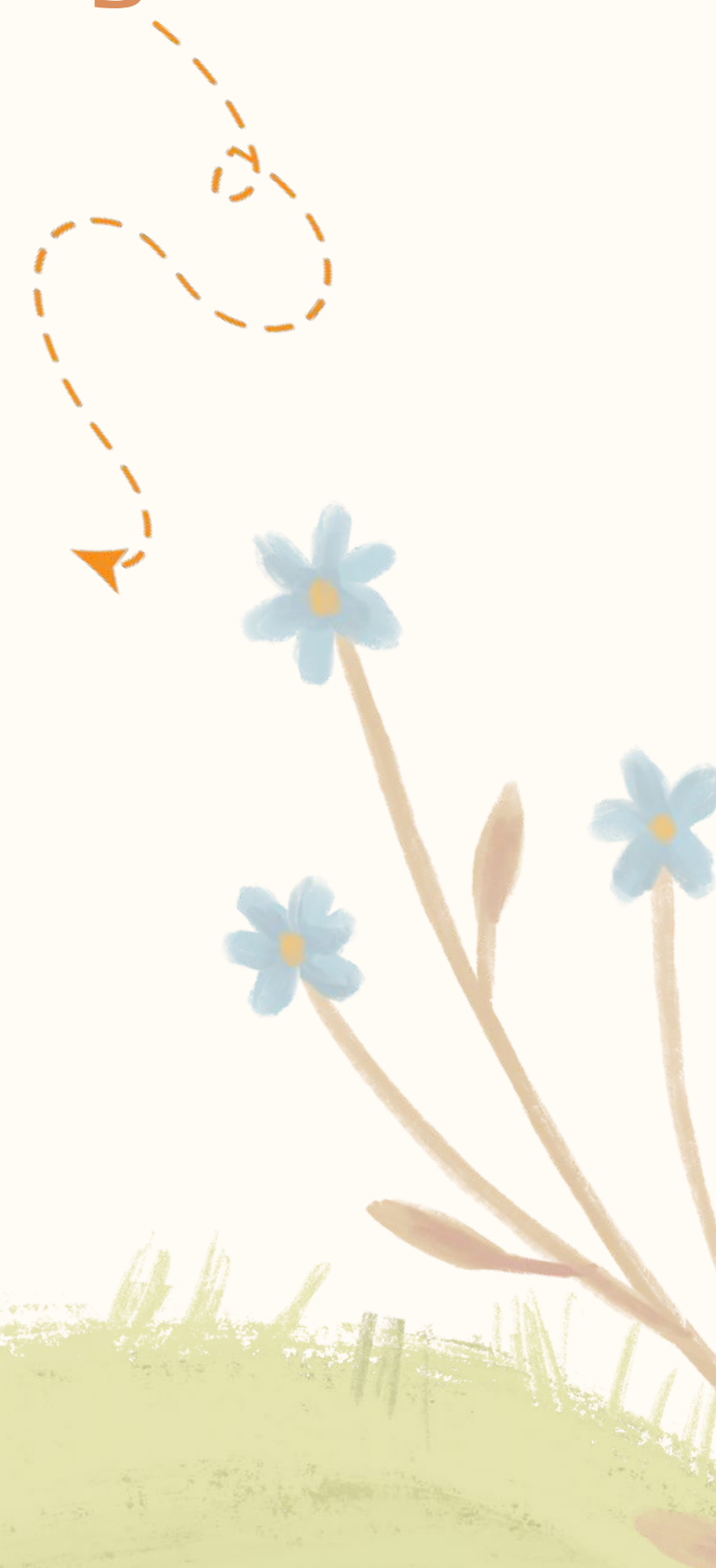
Placement in ELL Program & Current Language Demographics

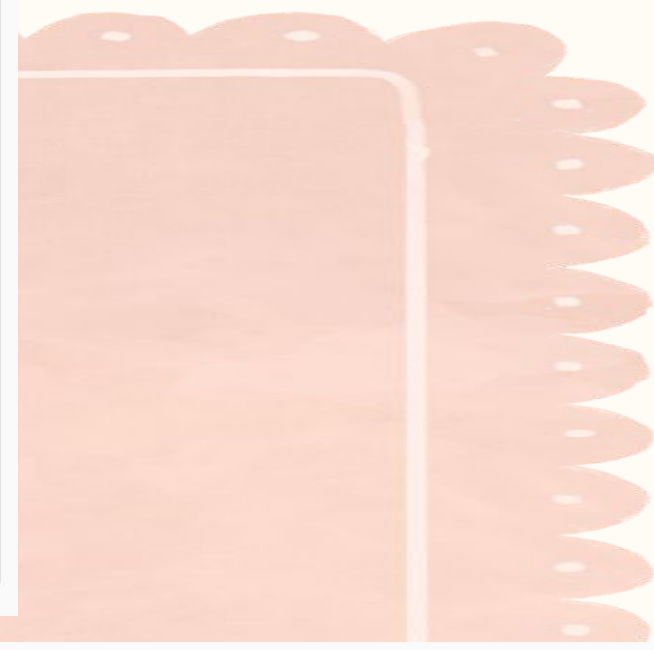

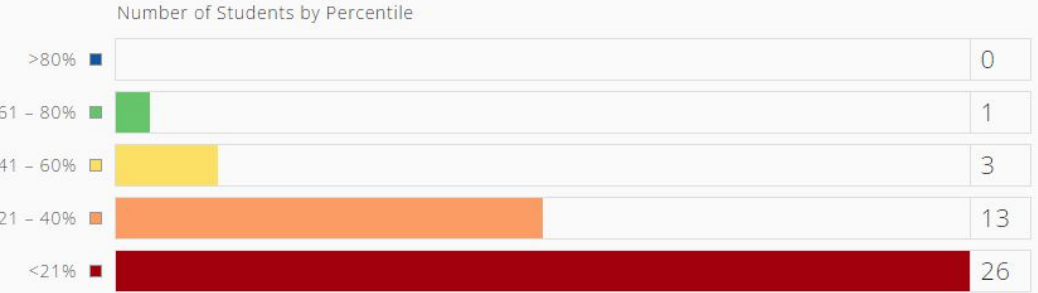

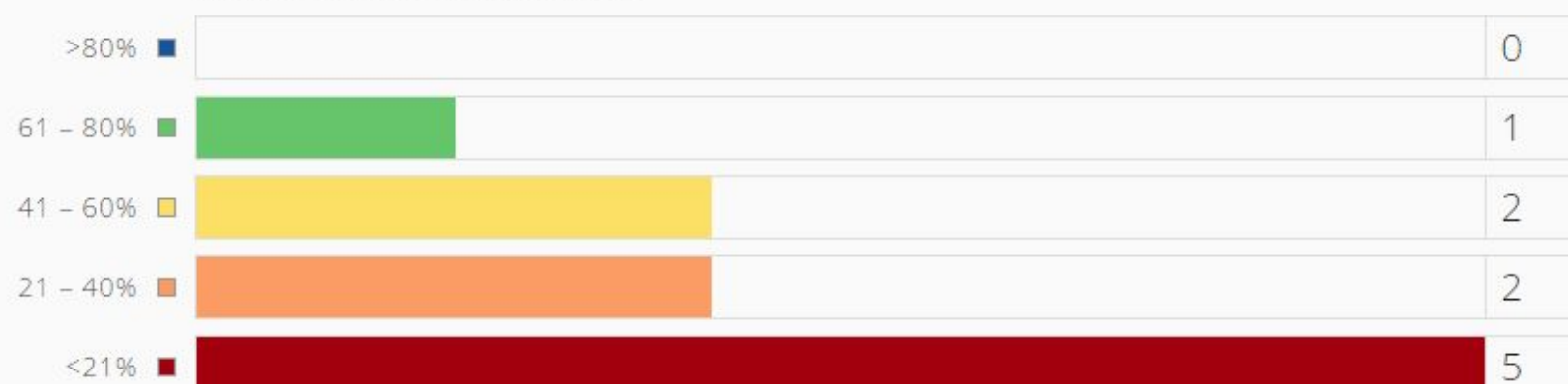

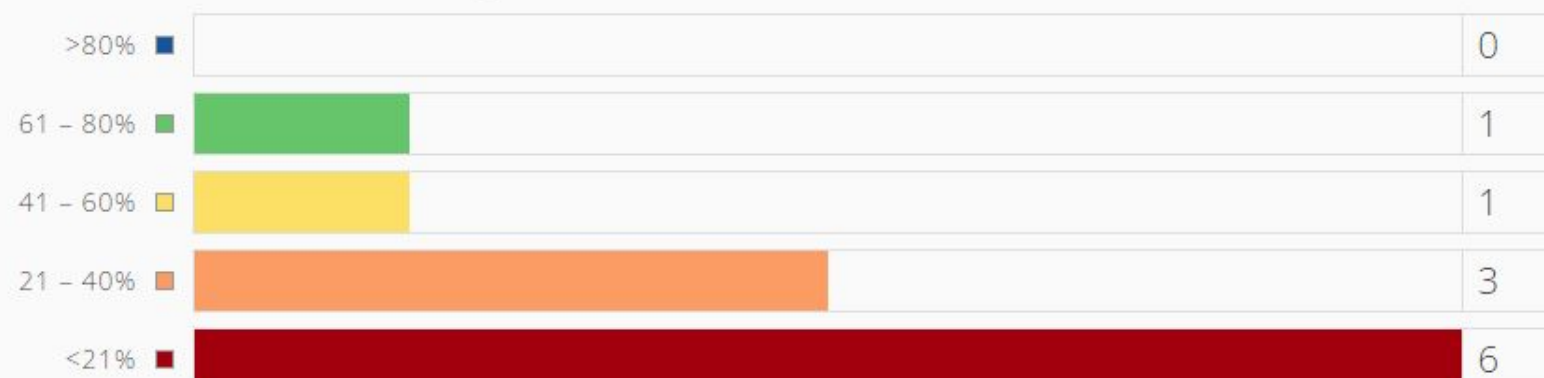

Performance Distribution, By Test Group: GENTRY SCHOOL DISTRICT, 2022-2023

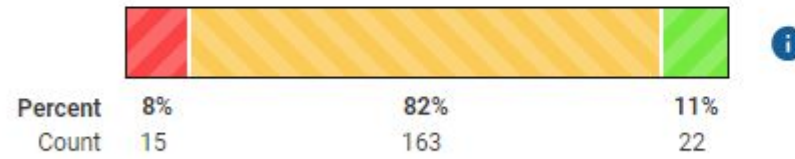

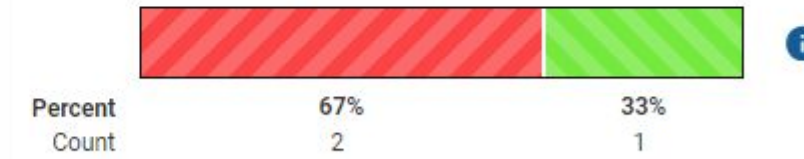

Strengths

- Growth from Fall to Winter across grade levels
- At or above state average of student testing Proficient on ELPA21 in lower grade levels

Areas to Improve

- Low growth overall
- Growth decreases as students progress into higher grades
- Students testing Proficient on ELPA21 decreases in upper grade levels

Action Steps

- Continue participating in ELA PLTs
- Attend additional content area PLTs 6-12 in order to support with ELL strategies in the classroom
- Continue weekly ESOL PLT meetings and incorporate more data
- Implement coaching cycles with ELD teachers
- Work with building level admin to provide PD for content area teachers
- Work with other MCLs to provide support, interventions, and plan for our ELLs - working smarter!

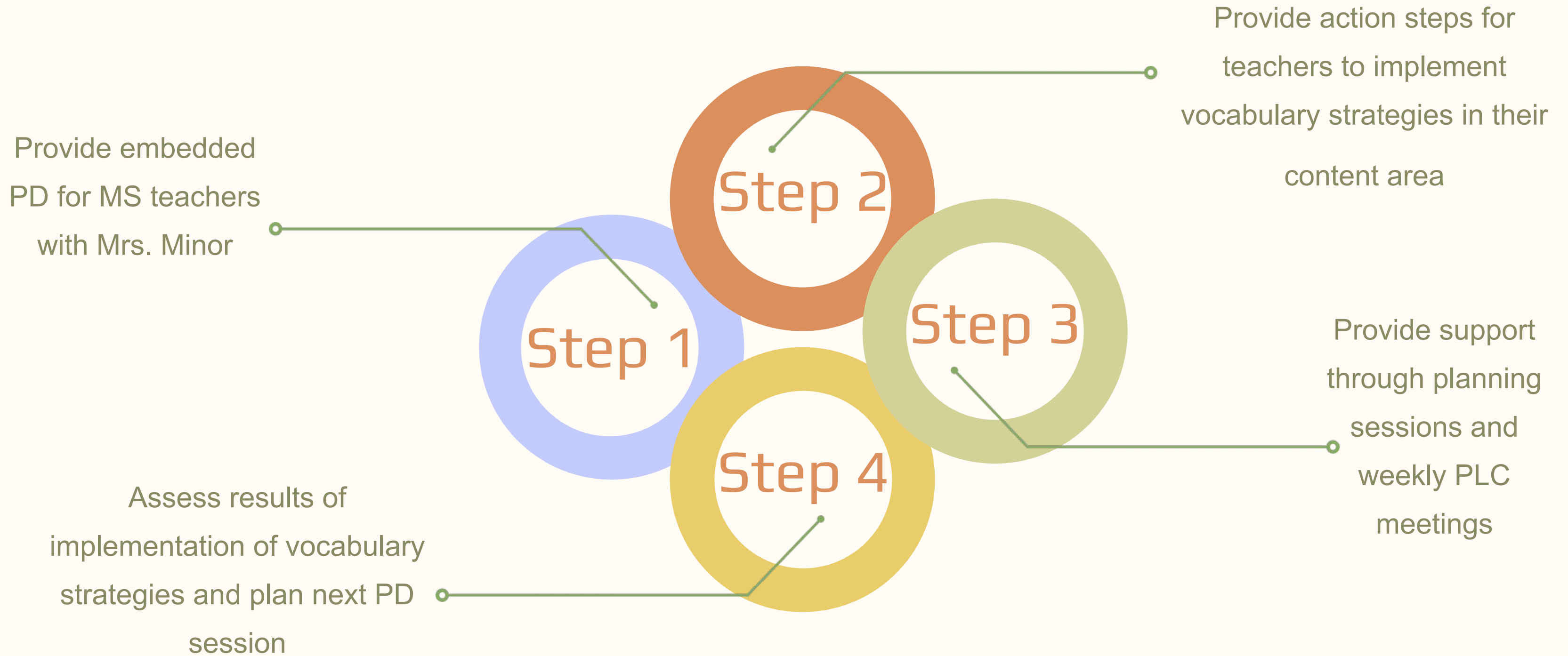

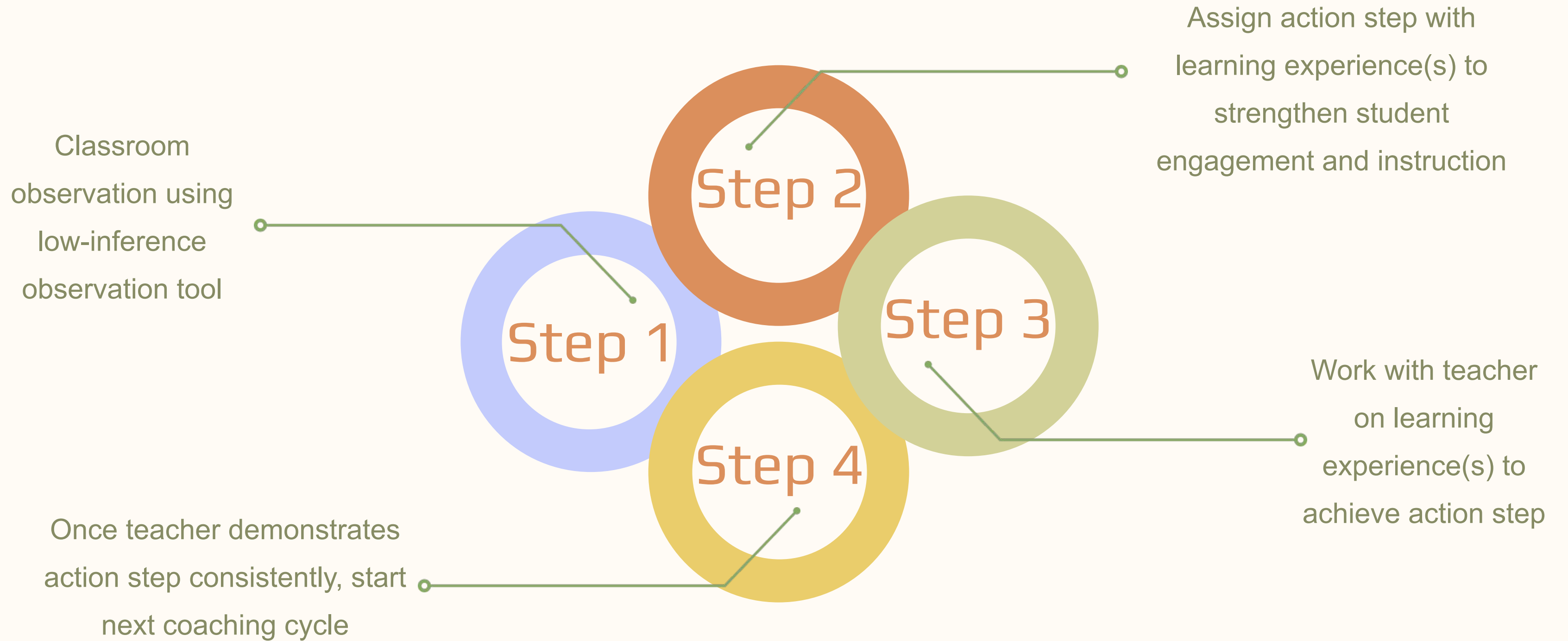
